



## About HIP6 (Hartford Inclusive Play)

Six new inclusive Boundless playgrounds serving children with and without disabilities will be built in Greater Hartford. Together, these playgrounds will serve more than 200,000 children in communities where up to 19% of the children have disabilities.

HIP6 is the largest civic undertaking of its kind, placing Hartford at the forefront of the national inclusive play movement.

### THE HIP6 COMMUNITIES

#### **Bolton (Bolton Center School)**

*Sponsored by the Bolton Center School Playscape Committee – recognizing that a safe and welcoming environment for students and residents starts on the playground*

- Up to 10,000 children served
- 5.5% of the children have disabilities

#### **East Windsor (Pierce Park)**

*Sponsored by the Town of East Windsor – breaking down barriers and eliminating stereotypes against children with disabilities*

- Up to 25,000 children served
- 8.1% of the children have disabilities

#### **Hartford (Greater Hartford YMCA)**

*Sponsored by the Greater Hartford YMCA – providing a community gathering space for children and families of all abilities in Hartford's North End*

- More than 100,000 children served
- 19% of the children have disabilities

#### **Hartford (Lozada Park)**

*Sponsored by the Society of Latin Firefighters – serving as a community hub in this underserved neighborhood*

- More than 100,000 children served
- 19% of the children have disabilities

#### **Windsor (Clover Street School)**

*Sponsored by the Clover Street School Playground Committee – replacing an outdated playscape so ALL children can play together*

- Up to 50,000 children served
- 7.5% of the children have disabilities

#### **Windsor Locks (South Elementary School)**

*Sponsored by South Elementary School – upgrading the existing playground and invite other surrounding schools to share in the experience of inclusive play*

- More than 25,000 children served
- 5.8% of the children have disabilities
